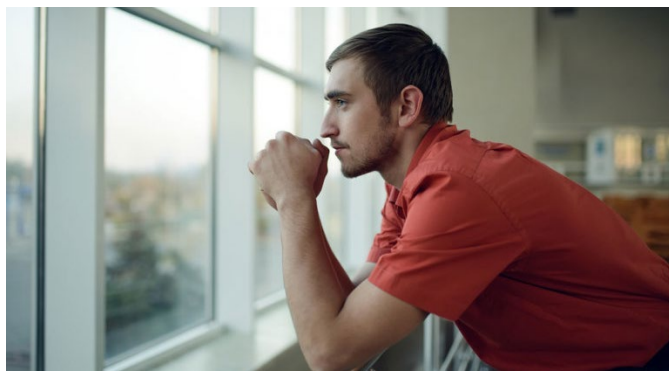

What is Drug Addiction?

When we refer to drug addiction, we're discussing the physical and psychological dependence on substances such as cocaine, heroin, or opioids. Addiction exercises a powerful and dangerous hold on your brain, which reveals itself in a few distinct ways. The first way is that you crave the substance.

In other words, you repeatedly have urges to use the drug. In addition, you may struggle to control your use of the drug. You may also continue to use the substance even if using it has adverse consequences.



Nearly every type of drug, whether you're using heroin or methamphetamine, causes a powerful surge of dopamine in your brain. Once your mind begins to associate the use of the drug to that surge of dopamine, it starts rewiring itself, causing it to forget how to function without the drug. The more you take the drug, the more difficult it is to stop using it.

Unfortunately, the more you use the substance, the more of the drug your brain will tolerate. As a result, you may find that you need to take more of the drug to get the same result. You may also observe that you battle withdrawal symptoms when you do not use the drug. 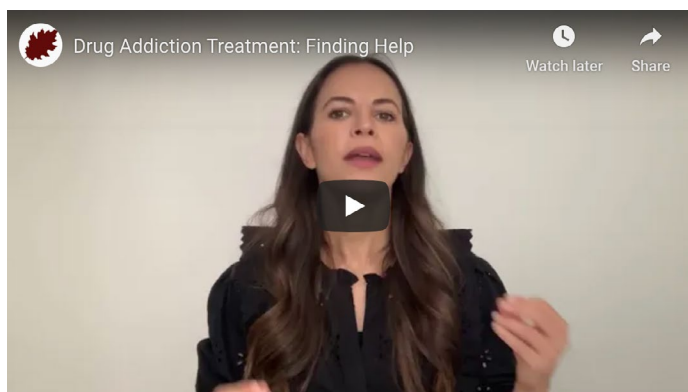
